Antoine DREYFUSS was born in 1977 in Suresnes. He continued his horn studies at the regional conservatory of Limoges in Eric HULIN's class, where he obtained a gold medal with honours from the jury in 1994, as well as a gold medal in chamber music.

Having won an honorary prize, with higher degree, of the Kingdom of Music (1993), he entered the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique of Paris in 1994, in André CAZALET's class, where he obtained a first prize unanimously in 1998. At the same time, he attended Jens McManama's chamber music class, where he won another unanimous first prize.

As a member of Orchestre Français des Jeunes (1995-1996), he is regularly invited by major ensembles such as Lausanne Chamber Orchestra, Dresden Philharmonic, Orchestre de Paris and Orchestre of the Opéra National of Paris. Since 1998, he has held the position of Principal Horn with Orchestre Philharmonique de Radio-France.

Contemporary music is also part of his repertoire as he is a member of the ensembles L'itinéraire and Court-Circuit. He also performs as a soloist with various French orchestras and as a chamber musician. As such, he is a member of Turbulences brass quintet and Lutetia wind quintet. In addition, in 1999 he joined Paris-Bastille Wind Octet, where he performs regularly.
