



**Loïc Chevandier**

Bassoon

Born in Calais in 1973, Loïc Chevandier first studied bassoon at the ENM in Calais and then fagott at the regional conservatory in Lille, where he won a gold medal in 1995. He continued his training at the Geneva International Conservatory in Roger Birnstingl's class and then at the Conservatoire National Supérieur de Musique of Paris in Pascal Gallois's class from 1996. He graduated in 1999 and continued his studies in wind quintet in David Walter's chamber music class, first in the graduate cycle (Obtaining the Chamber Music Prize in 2001) and then in the Advanced Studies Cycle.

During his training, Loïc Chevandier has occasionally worked with Bernard Thomas Orchestra, Société des Concerts Lamoureux, Intercontemporain Ensemble, Opéra Éclaté company, Rouen Opera Orchestra (conductor Oswald Sallaberger), Banquet Orchestra (conductor Olivier Dejours), Ensemble Orchestral of Paris and Court-Circuit Ensemble, of which he has been a member since 2003. In addition, he has been teaching since 2002 at the Chatou Music School (Yvelines).
